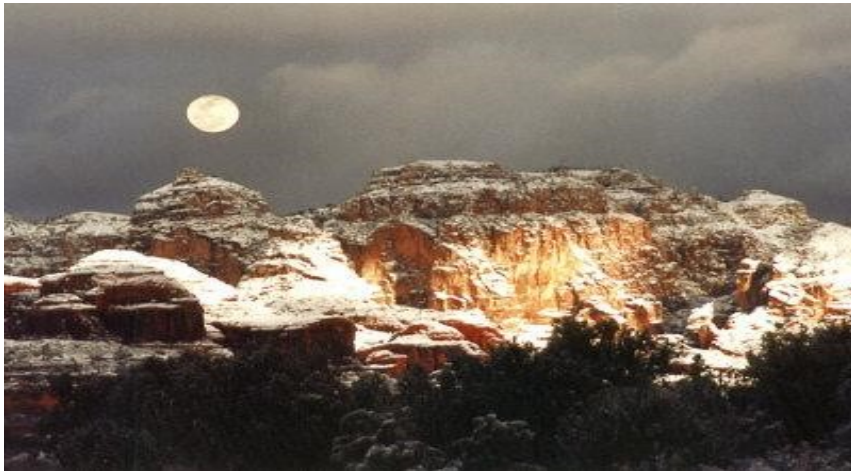

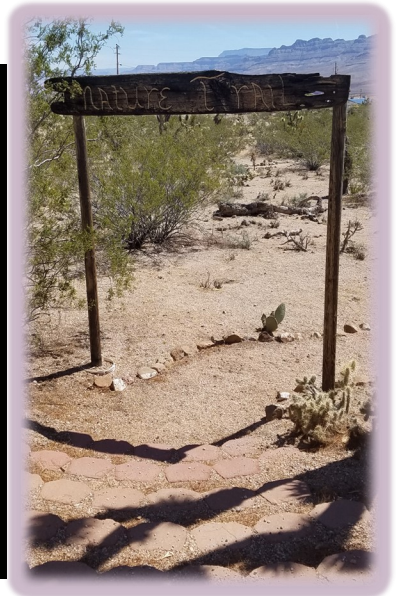

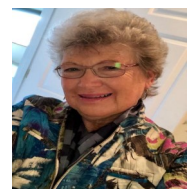

President's Letter to the Members

Temperatures are cooling down and the days are getting shorter. Fall is here and winter will be arriving soon. The Explorers and Ridgeriders are back and in full swing. The Ridgeriders will have there first meeting Saturday November 5th at 8:30am. The auditorium will be closed November 7th at 3:00pm for the setup of the election. Then on November 8th voting for the election will start at 7:00am. Remember every vote counts! I hope everyone has gotten signed up for the Thanksgiving Craft fair on Saturday November 26th from 9am-2:pm. We still have the front sidewalk, back patio, and outdoor tables available. Now I would like to give an explanation on the difference between Members and Non members: A member is a person who is listed as the legal deed holder of property within the Meadview Civic Association boundaries and listed at the Mohave County Assessor's Office as same for at least one (1) year, and who is current with all MCA fees, and who is in compliance with all state mandates. If a person owns property in the Meadview Civic Association, they must become a mandatory title owner to use any part of the facility with all assessments transferring to the next owner if the lot is sold. Non-member's do not fall under the umbrella of the MCA Property Owner Association which gives the non-member no privileges to the facility. Guests are defined as the following: A person who does not own real property in Meadview, Lake Mead City or the surrounding are of Meadview. A person who is visiting an MCA member in good standings, come to visit infrequently . All guest, children and dependents must be accompanied by the member all the times. Guest may not be given a key card, No key card will be given out until the MCA receives proof of the "Recorded Deed" in the member's name. Upon verification of all assessments/fees and documentation, one Key Card will be issued per recorded owner. And as always, the use of the facility is a privilege not a right.

Happy Fall you all!!

This summer was one of the hottest on record. With the help of BLM we were able to water the Joshua Trees in our reclamation site mid June and then came the monsoons.

The Forest received adequate rain and our reclamation site has flourished. In fact the seeds we planted have resulted in new penstemon plants and deserts marigold.

We have placed new trash containers at the kiosk trailhead one for recycles and one for trash. Unfortunately not always do our visitors get the refuse in the containers. We separate the recyclables both at the trailhead and when we do our pick up along the Pearce Ferry Road. Without having a company that will pickup recycles and no place in Kingman that takes the majority of our recyclables we have to stock pile them until one of our members travel to Las Vegas to complete the recycling. There is a company that is willing to pickup recyclables right here in Meadview. We wouldn't have even have to sort them. They also provide the containers. We need at least 100 to sign up for this service. The information is in the Post Office annex. Please consider signing up for recyclable pick up. Having a company that picks up those recyclables regularly would be a huge help to us. The money and time we spend distributing the recyclables could be better spent working toward a National Monument designation.

In November our festival committee will start planning for the spring festival. If you are interested in helping plan for the festival let us know. We are at our office in the Post Office Annex Monday-Friday 2-4. Watch for us at the COM meetings and the Farmers Markey. You can also contact us at our e-mail or on the website.

Calling a Few Good Friends to help us with staffing the office, outreach events, environmental education, docent lead walks, Children's art classes, local art exhibit(how our Joshua Forest benefits our community) reclamation Forest in the National Monument program.

We are looking forward to a successful and reenergizing 2023. Thank you to our amazing community for moving us forward.

Meadview Civic Association Inc. The purpose of our organization is to foster & encourage the civic advancement of our members and/or property owners. However, Social Membership applications are also cogitated. In August of 1970, the owners of the Meadview subdivision determined that to maintain the friendly small town attraction of Meadview, a central meeting & recreational facility was needed. They set up the MCA with involuntary membership to property owners. A number of Meadview families agreed and the Articles of Incorporation were created and accepted by the State of Arizona. With an \$80,000 loan to erect the facility; construction of the lounge, kitchen and pool began January of 1971 and completed in July that same year.
